## **The 2<sup>nd</sup> Territory-wide Inter-school Basic Law Competition Regulations**

### **Theme**

- Understanding Justice and Law, Living a Colourful Life

### **Aims**

- To enhance students' understanding of the Basic Law, including its origins and the spirit of the constitution;
- To guide students to understand the constitutional status of Hong Kong under the Basic Law; and
- To develop students' understanding of the relationship between the Basic Law and the lives of Hong Kong people, including rights and responsibilities

### **Secondary Section (Secondary One to Secondary Three)**

The competition for secondary schools consists of the heat and the final.

#### (1) Heat (online competition)

- Date and time for the competition
  - Students can enter the competition for the secondary section between 24 May 2016 (Tuesday) and 25 May 2016 (Wednesday) on the designated website which is accessible from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
  - Schools may make arrangements for the entrants to take part in the competition at the same time or at different time slots.
- Number of entrants
  - No limit on the number of entrants from each school
- Details
  - This part of the competition is staged online.
  - Each student can take part in the competition once only. They should answer 30 questions within 15 minutes. The competition is based on the speed and accuracy of answering the questions, as well as the student participation rate. Students who are found to take part in the competition more than once during the two-day period will be disqualified.
  - To ensure fairness and impartiality, students should take part in the competition

under the supervision of teachers at school.

- Students are not allowed to refer to any information or materials during the competition.
  - Entrants should log into the student accounts of Hong Kong Education City and access the competition website (<http://www.hkedcity.net/basiclaw/sec>) on desktop computers, laptops or tablet computers connected to the school wired or wireless network.
  - Of the 30 schools with the highest student participation rate, the five schools with the highest average scores will reach the final. In case of ties, the time spent on completing the online questions will be adopted as the criterion. No appeal will be accepted. Schools will compete in teams in the final.
- Pre-competition trial run
    - The organising committee will allow entrants two days to familiarise themselves with the competition mode on the webpage of Hong Kong Education City (<http://www.hkedcity.net/basiclaw/sec>).
    - The trial run for secondary section is scheduled for 10 May 2016 (Tuesday) and 11 May 2016 (Wednesday).
  - Awards
    - To encourage schools' active participation, the following will be awarded:
      - The Most Active Participation Award will be given to 30 schools with the highest student participation rate. In case of ties, the award will be given on the basis of the average scores and the time spent on completing the questions.
      - Of those receiving the Most Active Participation Award, the five schools with the highest average scores (the time spent on completing the online questions will be adopted as the criterion in case of ties) will enter the final.
  - Announcement of results
    - The competition results will be announced under “What’s New” on the website of the Moral, Civic and National Education Section of the EDB (<http://www.edb.gov.hk/cd/mcne>) at 5:00 p.m. on 13 June 2016 (Monday). Schools going through to the final will receive notification by post.

## (2) Final

- Date and time
  - 6 July 2016 (Wednesday) (AM)

- Venue
  - The Hong Kong Institute of Education
  
- Numbers of entrants
  - Five school teams with three members who have entered the heat will go through to the final.
  - Each school can enter only one team, which can be made up of students from any year level or a combination of levels.
  - The list of contestants for the final must be submitted on or before 20 June 2016 (Monday). No further changes will be accepted upon submission.
  
- Medium
  - Cantonese
  
- Other details about the competition will be announced later.
  
- Awards
  - First, second and third prizes and two merit prizes
    - All prize winning schools will receive a trophy and each winning student a medal and a certificate.
    - Each member of the first prize winning team will receive a laptop.
    - Each member of the second prize winning team will receive a tablet computer.
    - Each member of the third prize winning team will receive a tablet computer.
    - Each merit prize winner will receive four admission tickets to a theme park.
    - The first-, second- and third-prize winning schools will give an interview during the radio programme “Super Classroom” of Digital Broadcasting Corporation (DBC).
  - The “Best Cheering Team Award” will also be presented. The winning school will receive a trophy and book coupons.

## **Primary Section (Primary Four to Primary Six)**

The competition for primary schools consists of the heat and the final.

### (1) Heat (online competition)

- Date and time for the competition
  - Students can enter the competition for the primary section between 26 May 2016 (Thursday) and 27 May 2016 (Friday) on the designated website which is accessible from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
  - Schools may make arrangements for the entrants to take part in the competition at the same time or at different time slots.
  
- Number of entrants
  - No limit on the number of entrants from each school
  
- Details
  - This part of the competition is staged online.
  - Each student can take part in the competition once only. They should answer 30 questions within 15 minutes. The competition is based on the speed and accuracy of answering the questions, as well as the student participation rate. Students who are found to take part in the competition more than once during the two-day period will be disqualified.
  - To ensure fairness and impartiality, students should take part in the competition under the supervision of teachers at school.
  - Students are not allowed to refer to any information or materials during the competition.
  - Entrants should log into the student accounts of Hong Kong Education City and access the competition website (<http://www.hkedcity.net/basiclaw/pri>) on desktop computers, laptops or tablet computers connected to the school wired or wireless network.
  - Of the 30 schools with the highest student participation rate, the five schools with the highest average scores will reach the final. In case of ties, the time spent on completing the online questions will be adopted as the criterion. No appeal will be accepted. School teams will be entered for the final.
  
- Pre-competition trial run
  - The organising committee will allow entrants two days to familiarise themselves with the competition mode on the webpage of Hong Kong Education City

(<http://www.hkedcity.net/basiclaw/pri>).

- The trial run for primary schools is scheduled for 12 May 2016 (Thursday) and 13 May 2016 (Friday).

- Awards

- To encourage schools' active participation, the following will be awarded:
  - The Most Active Participation Award will be given to 30 schools with the highest student participation rate. In case of ties, the award will be given on the basis of the average scores and the time spent on completing the questions.
  - Of those receiving the Most Active Participation Award, the five schools with the highest average scores (the time spent on completing the online questions will be adopted as the criterion in case of ties) will enter the final.

- Announcement of results

- The competition results will be announced under "What's New" on the website of the Moral, Civic and National Education Section of the EDB (<http://www.edb.gov.hk/cd/mcne>) at 5:00 p.m. on 13 June 2016 (Monday). Schools going through to the final will receive notification by post.

- Schools interested in entering “The 2nd Territory-wide Inter-school Basic Law Competition” should log into the Principal, Teacher or School Administrator accounts of Hong Kong Education City (<http://www.hkedcity.net/basiclaw/reg>) and submit the completed entry form (Chinese version only) on or before 30 April 2016 (Saturday).
- The information collected will be used solely for the purpose of “The 2<sup>nd</sup> Territory-wide Inter-school Basic Law Competition”. Please ensure that the information entered is correct before submission.
- Please make sure that the student accounts of Hong Kong Education City for the current school year have been updated prior to the submission of entries, and distribute the account information to the entrants before the competition. Please approach the teacher in-charge or the IT coordinator in school for details. If further assistance is needed, please contact Hong Kong Education City.
