Administrative Arrangements for Applications related to Language Proficiency Requirement (LPR) for Teachers of English / Putonghua:

- (i) Entry for the Language Proficiency Assessment for Teachers (LPAT) 2022;
- (ii) Application for Exemption from the LPR; and
- (iii) Application for the LPR Certificate of Merit and Attainment Certificate

(Note: This circular memorandum should be read by supervisors / heads and teachers of all primary and secondary schools)

Summary

This circular memorandum provides information on LPR-related applications. The purpose of this circular memorandum is to announce the administrative arrangements for (i) entry for the LPAT 2022; (ii) application for exemption from the LPR; and (iii) application for the LPR Certificate of Merit and Attainment Certificate. Related application forms can be downloaded from the Education Bureau (EDB) website (<u>www.edb.gov.hk/lpr</u>). Applicants should read relevant information on the above website before submitting an application.

Details

2. According to the LPR policy, all new / newly deployed teachers of English / Putonghua holding a permanent post should at least have met the LPR in all the core language skills¹ before teaching the respective language subjects. They have to meet the LPR in Classroom Language Assessment (CLA) within the first year of their taking up the teaching duties. There are two channels to attain the LPR: (i) taking the LPAT and / or (ii) applying for exemption from the LPR if they hold appropriate qualifications. Applicants who have fully attained the LPR or have attained an overall proficiency level of 4 or above can apply for the LPR Attainment Certificate or Certificate of Merit respectively.

Entry for the LPAT 2022

3. The LPAT 2022 is open for application from 1 to 20 September 2021. Applicants who wish to sit for the LPAT 2022 should submit their applications via the online registration system. Detailed information on the LPAT will be available on the EDB website

(www.edb.gov.hk/lpat) and Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) website (www.hkeaa.edu.hk) in late August. Upon the commencement of application, related application forms can also be downloaded on the aforesaid HKEAA website. Application for Exemption from the LPR

4. Applications for exemption from the LPR are accepted all year round and processed in two batches. In the 2021/22 school year, applications submitted by **30 November 2021** will be processed in the first batch and submission by **31 May 2022** will be processed in the second batch. Related application forms and detailed information are available on the EDB website (www.edb.gov.hk/exemption). Provided that applicants submit all the necessary supporting documents / information with their applications, they will be informed of the results individually in about three months from the respective deadlines for submission.

Application for the LPR Certificate of Merit and Attainment Certificate

5. Applications for the LPR certificate are accepted all year round and processed in two batches. In the 2021/22 school year, applications submitted by **28 January 2022** will be processed in the first batch and submission by **30 June 2022** will be processed in the second batch. Related application forms and detailed information are available on the EDB website (<u>www.edb.gov.hk/cert</u>). Provided that applicants submit all the necessary supporting documents / information with the applications, they will receive the certificate collection notification by post in about three months from the respective deadlines for submission.
