**Summary**

2. With the aim of increasing general understanding of intellectual property (IP), member states of World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) designated 26 April as World IP Day to promote the role that IP rights play in encouraging innovation and creativity.

WIPO's World IP Day Youth Gallery (“Program”) recognises exceptional young people who have made a positive contribution to society and innovated for a better future.
