"2022 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" Programme

Summary

This circular memorandum aims to invite schools to take part in the "2022 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" programme jointly organised by the Education Bureau (EDB) and the Security Bureau for primary and secondary school students to promote the participation of teachers and students and enable national security education to take root in schools.

Background

2. 2022 marks the 25th anniversary of the establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR). It is also the second anniversary of the implementation of the Law of the People's Republic of China on Safeguarding National Security in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (Hong Kong National Security Law) since 30 June, 2020. The EDB and the Security Bureau take this important opportunity to jointly organise key activities. Through participation in these activities, teachers and students in Hong Kong will enhance their understanding of the Constitution, the Basic Law and national security, and unite in safeguarding national security.

Details

3. The EDB and the Security Bureau have designed a series of key activities for the "2022 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" programme. In view of the anti-epidemic arrangements, schools can arrange for students to participate in some of the activities which will be launched first. Schools can also encourage students to make good preparation for the following activities during the special vacation in March and April this year.

Key activities include:

- i). "2022 Slogan-cum-Poster Design Competition on National Security" (Annex 1), which enables students to think about how to accurately and concisely express the key points of national security through creative design. The related work will help enrich the publicity and promotion of national security on campus;
- ii). **"2022 National Security Online Quiz Competition" (Annex 2)**, which enhances students' understanding of the Constitution, the Basic Law and the national security, as well as their understanding of the rule of law and the developments of our country, and the importance of safeguarding national security.

The winning schools and students of the above activities will be invited to attend the award presentation ceremony of the "2022 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" programme jointly organised by the EDB and the Security Bureau in August 2022 (tentative).

4. The EDB has also compiled the **Suggested Learning and Teaching Activities for National Security Education [Examples] (Annex 3)** for schools' reference, and

will continue to provide diversified resources related to Constitution, Basic Law and national security education through the web-based resource platform "National Education One-stop Portal" (www.edb.gov.hk/en/neosp) to help schools promote national education and foster students' sense of national identity and awareness of safeguarding national security.

Annex 1

2022 Slogan-cum-Poster Design Competition on National Security

Objectives

The competition aims to encourage students to uphold positive values and demonstrate their understanding of national security in a creative and artistic way through designing slogans and posters on the theme of national security. Schools can make use of the entries to promote activities related to national security education on campus and in the community.

Eligibility

- Lower Primary Section: Primary 1-3 students
- Upper Primary Section: Primary 4-6 students
- Junior Secondary Section: Secondary 1-3 students
- Senior Secondary Section: Secondary 4-6 students

Topics

- Primary Sections: "National Security Makes Lives Better"
 - Write a slogan and produce a poster in one of the following areas on the topic of safeguarding national security to make lives better for Hong Kong residents.
 - ♦ Hong Kong National Security Law
 - \diamond One or more of the domains of national security¹
 - ♦ Safeguarding national security at individual level
 - The slogan designed for an entry should match the above topic and the content of the poster.
- Secondary Sections: "The Hong Kong National Security Law ensures longterm prosperity and stability of Hong Kong"
 - Write a slogan and produce a poster in one of the following areas to demonstrate the importance of national security to individuals, society and the country:

¹According to the "Curriculum Framework of National Security Education in Hong Kong", the domains of national security include political security, homeland security, military security, economic security, cultural security, social security, technological security, cyber security, ecological security, resource security, nuclear security, overseas interests security and security in new domains (including biosecurity, space security, deep sea security, polar security).

- Hong Kong National Security Law enables Hong Kong to restore order and rebuild prosperity
- Hong Kong National Security Law ensures the steadfast and successful implementation of "One Country, Two Systems"
- ♦ Safeguarding national security at individual, societal and national levels
- The slogan designed for each entry should match the selected area and the content of the poster.

Mode of Entry

- Students enter the competition on an individual basis, and each student can only submit one entry.
- Each student should be coached by one teacher, and each teacher may coach more than one student.
- There is no limit on the number of entries submitted by each school.
- Please refer to the following ("Competition Rules") for the formats and requirements of entries.

Competition Rules

Formats and requirements for entries:

- Students are required to produce posters in two dimensions. There are no restrictions on the format and materials.
- Entries must be a graphic design with colours in A3 size (297 mm x 420 mm) and can be hand-drawn or computer-designed.
- Entries must be presented in Chinese and/or English.
- Entries must be the entrants' original works and not have been released publicly.
- The content of entries should not reveal information related to the participating schools or the entrants.
- Entries should be converted into electronic files for submission.
- The resolution of electronic files should be no less than 300dpi.

Submission of entries:

• Schools should duly complete the entry form online and upload the electronic files of the entries (must be in BMP/ JPEG/ PDF/ PNG/ TIFF format) via the following websites or QR codes on or before 6 June 2022 (Monday).

Judging Criteria

- Content of slogan and poster (50%)
- Creative design (30%)
- Artistic skill (20%)

Adjudicating Panel

• Entries will be assessed by a committee comprising members of the Curriculum Development Council, Curriculum Development Council Standing Committee on Values Education, Working Group on Teachers and Students of the Basic Law Promotion Steering Committee and the Security Bureau.

Awards

- The following awards will be given to each section:
 - > Individual awards: First, Second and Third Prizes, and Honourable Mention;
 - > "2022 Slogan-cum-Poster Design Competition on National Security: Excellent

Design Award";

- "2022 Slogan-cum-Poster Design Competition on National Security: Active Promotion School Award": The award will be given to the 10 schools with the most student entries in each section.
- Winning schools will each receive a trophy, while winning students will each receive a certificate and a prize.
- Students who have participated in the "Basic Law Student Ambassadors Training Scheme" organised by the EDB and can successfully submit their entries for this competition will be awarded one point. Those who win an individual award in this competition will be awarded one extra point.

Use of Winning Entries

- Winning entries of individual awards will be produced into banners for school display and publicity.
- Winning entries may be displayed on public transport and at government venues for public viewing to promote national security and offer encouragement to the winning students.
- Entries and winning entries may be used for promotional purposes by the EDB and the Security Bureau, including but not limited to producing posters and publicity materials, etc.
- Entries and winning entries may be uploaded to the websites and social platforms of the EDB and the Security Bureau for sharing with various stakeholders.

Competition Schedule

Points to Note for Schools

- The EDB reserves the right to change, suspend or terminate the activity any time. If there are any changes, announcements will be made on the EDB's "National Education One-stop Portal".
- The EDB reserves the right to change the competition awards without prior notice.
- Once an entry is submitted, it cannot be modified, re-uploaded or returned.
- Participating schools should keep the original posters until further notice from the EDB.
- The entry submission date and time will be based on the date and time indicated in the EDB's server system.
- Participating schools should ensure that information and content included in their entries are in line with the curriculum aims and objectives set out by the EDB, not obscene, abusive, violent, defamatory, etc., as well as do not violate the laws of the HKSAR. Otherwise, the entrants will be disqualified.
- All entries must be the entrants' original works, and not have been released publicly. They must not infringe copyrights or interests of any other party, otherwise the entrants will be held responsible for any disputes arising therefrom and may be disqualified from the competition. If necessary, the EDB may request the entrants to produce written proof of legal authorisation.
- The EDB reserves the right to reject or disqualify any entries without giving particular reasons.
- The EDB reserves the right to use the entrants' works (including school names) in whole or part for non-profit-making purposes, and to edit, translate, adapt, use, copy, distribute and upload the entries to the Internet without prior consent of the entrants.

2022 National Security Online Quiz Competition

Objectives

The competition aims to increase students' understanding of the Constitution, the Basic Law and the national security, as well as to promote their understanding of the rule of law and the developments of our country, the importance of safeguarding national security, the close relationship between national security and our daily lives, and the importance of national security to individuals, society and the country.

Eligibility

- Primary Section: Primary 1-6 students
- Secondary Section: Secondary 1-6 students

Details

- The competition will be held in the form of an online quiz, and there is no limit on the number of participants from each school. Participation by all students is encouraged.
- Participants should enter the competition by logging into the following website using their Hong Kong Education City accounts from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.² during the period from 23 May (Monday) to 6 June (Monday) 2022.
- Schools may make arrangement for students to participate in the competition all at the same time or in batches. It is also possible for students to participate in the competition at home.

- Part 2 Quiz Questions: Students are required to answer 10 questions within 10 minutes. Some of the questions are based on the content of the following website.
 - Exhibition of the 1st Anniversary of the Promulgation of the Hong Kong National Security Law (https://nslexhibition.hk)



- Each student can only attempt once. Students found to have attempted more than once will be disqualified.
- The criteria for winning the competition are based on the participation rate, level of accuracy and length of time used.
- No request for appeal will be entertained.

Awards

- The following awards will be given to each section:
 - Most Active Participation School Award (territory-wide)": The award will be given to the 30 schools with the highest student participation rates in each section. In case of a tie, the average score and the total time used in answering Part 1 and Part 2 questions will be compared in deciding which school(s) should receive the award.
 - "District Outstanding School Award": The school with the highest average score in each of the 18 districts³ in each section will be given the award.
 - Individual awards: The awards include First, Second and Third Prizes, and Honourable Mention (based on the level of accuracy in Part 1 and Part 2). In case of a tie, the total time used in answering Part 1 and Part 2 questions will be compared in deciding which student(s) to receive the award(s).
- A certificate will be awarded to each participating school and student.
- Those entrants who have participated in the "Basic Law Student Ambassadors Training Scheme" organised by the EDB will be awarded one point, and those who win an individual award in this competition will be awarded one extra point.

Entry

• Schools interested in entering the "2022 National Security Online Quiz Competition" should log into Hong Kong Education City by accessing its website (www.edcity.hk/national-security/reg) with their principal, teacher or school administrator accounts, follow the



instructions thereon and submit a completed entry form (Chinese only) <u>from 3</u> <u>May (Tuesday) to 18 May (Wednesday) 2022</u>. Schools that fail to complete the entry procedures before the deadline will be disqualified and their results in the competition, if any, will not be admitted.

- The information submitted by schools will be used for the "2022 National Security Online Quiz Competition". Participating schools should ensure that all information provided is correct before submitting the entry form. Provision of incorrect information may affect their eligibility for entering the competition and results.
- Schools should confirm that their students' accounts with the Hong Kong Education City have been renewed for the current school year prior to the submission of an entry form, and inform their students of the account information accordingly before the competition. School may work out the arrangement with their teacher-in-charge or information technology co-ordinator. If further assistance is required, schools may approach the Hong Kong Education City.

Explain the learning elements of national security education during classes of various key learning areas / subjects and moral, civic and national education.

- Introduce the legislative background, meaning and main content of the Hong Kong National Security Law on school bulletin boards.
- Arrange students to collect information, engage in project learning or share their knowledge on the various domains of national security, such as cultural security, ecological security, resource security, economic security, public security, cyber security and other integral parts of the national security framework.
- Organise inter-class / inter-form competitions under the theme of national security, such as quiz competition on the developments of our country, bulletin board design, poster design, slogan writing and drama performance.
- Optimise school-based life-wide learning activities by making good use of the learning and teaching resources developed by the Curriculum Development Institute of the EDB, including "Little National Affairs Experts" Interactive Quiz Game Resource Pack (Chinese only) and wall-chart resources on the themes of "Event Book on Hong Kong's Return to China", "Human Rights and the Rule of Law" and "The Constitution and the Basic Law" (Chinese only).
