Revised Daily Rates of Pay for Supply Teachers and Supply Staff

Summary

This circular memorandum announces the revised rates of pay for supply teachers and supply staff in aided schools with effect from 1 September 2022.

2. With effect from 1 September 2022, the daily rates of pay for supply teachers and supply staff in aided schools are revised as follows:
