Applied Learning Scholarship (2021/22 School Year)

Aims

This is to invite schools offering Applied Learning (ApL) courses (including adapted ApL courses) in the 2021/22 school year to nominate students for the captioned scholarship.

Details

- 2. The ApL Scholarship is co-organised by the Law's Charitable Foundation (LCF) and the Education Bureau (EDB) to show our appreciation to Secondary 5 students who demonstrated positive learning attitude and achieved good progress in their study of ApL courses. The scholarship will be awarded to a maximum of 550 students.
- 3. All schools with students taking ApL courses in the 2021/22 school year are eligible to nominate students for the scholarship. The maximum number of student nominees from each school is set according to the number of **Secondary 5 (S5) students** enrolled in ApL courses in the 2021/22 school year. Schools with 25 or fewer S5 students taking ApL courses can nominate one student for the scholarship; schools with 26 to 50 S5 students taking ApL courses can nominate up to two students, and so on. Relevant course providers are also eligible to nominate students for the scholarship. The Steering Committee of the ApL Scholarship will assess the applications and select awardees. Each awardee will receive a scholarship of HK\$1,000 and a certificate issued by the LCF.
- 4. The EDB will send to schools the "Learning Progress Report" (as at 31 August 2022) via the Communication and Delivery System of the WebSAMS by the end of October 2022, to help schools better understand the learning progress of students in preparing for the nomination. For the learning progress of students studying adapted ApL course(s), schools may refer to the feedback from the course provider(s), such as on students' learning progress, performance and assessment results.
- 5. Schools intending to nominate students for the scholarship should complete and submit the attached nomination form (Appendix 1b) to the LCF on or before 16 December 2022 (Friday). For details, please refer to the Notes on Nomination overleaf (Appendix 1a) and the website of the LCF (www.lawscharitable.org.hk).

Notes on Nomination

Please refer to the Chinese version of the Notes on Nomination for details of the Applied Learning (ApL) Scholarship, including the nomination criteria and related information. A few key points are highlighted below for quick reference only. The Chinese version shall prevail should there be any inconsistency.

- Schools and course providers (CPs) are both eligible to nominate students for the ApL 1. Scholarship.
- All student nominees should have studied ApL course(s) at Secondary 5 (S5) in the 2021/22 2. school year (s.y.), regardless of whether it was their first or the second year of study.
- The nomination form consists of Form A1, Form A2 and Form B. Form A1/Form A2 should 3. be completed by the nominator (school/CP). For Form B, Part I should be completed by the nominator and Part II should be completed by the student nominee.
- In addition to the ApL Scholarship, all nominees will automatically be entered for the 4. nomination of "Special Awards". The Special Awards are to promote sharing of students' own learning experiences and stories, and the awards will be presented to those students with inspiring sharing.

- Schools and CPs should submit the original of the completed nomination forms to the LCF in person or by mail. - 2. Aims / Objectives

Background

2. The Education Bureau (EDB) has been further strengthening the promotion of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts and Mathematics) education both inside and outside the classroom to develop science and innovation and technology (I&T) education and equip students with competencies required in the 21st century, as well as to nurture I&T talents. To enrich the STEAM learning experiences beyond the classroom and inspire students' STEAM learning and motivation, the EDB will collaborate with various professional bodies or STEAM related organisations and bring in expertise to support schools.

Details

- 3. 

「創科博覽 2022」規劃概覽

<u> 背景:</u>

在國家科技部的支持下,基金會於 2016 年至 2018 年連續三年舉辦「創科博覽」,分別展示了國家在「十二五」期間,以至在航天、通訊、海洋、工業、農業、醫療方面的發展歷程,涵蓋古代中華科技文明成就,以及改革開放以來國家科技創新的重大成果。三屆「創科博覽」總共展出 27 日,有近 200 家內地參展單位的 350 多項展品赴港展出,基金會舉辦逾 700 場活動,累積吸引超過 33 萬人次進場,當中近半為學生;參與學校佔全港八成,夥伴機構合共超過1,300 家,講者和座談會嘉賓 380 多人,以及義工 700 多人。

去年國家在北京舉辦「十三五」規劃科技創新成果展,適逢 2022 年也是 香港特區成立 25 周年紀念,將是最好時機舉辦第四屆「創科博覽」。



Speak Up – Act Out! On Air! Improvised Drama Competition 2022/23

Aims / Objectives

This is to invite secondary schools to participate in the Speak Up – Act Out! On Air! Improvised Drama Competition 2022/23 organised by the Native-speaking English Teacher (NET) Section of the Education Bureau.

Details

- 2. The Speak Up Act Out! On Air! Improvised Drama Competition 2022/23 is a territory-wide competition designed to empower students to use audio drama to:
 - explore situations, characters, ideas and feelings both inside and outside the classroom;
 - express themselves creatively in English, and through physical and vocal expression;
 - develop their self-esteem, creativity, communication skills and collaboration skills; and
 - develop positive attitudes and values and generic skills, e.g. perseverance, commitment, care for others and respect for fair play.
- 3. In this competition, which will be held with online video conferencing in March 2023, students work in teams of 4 to 6 to create and perform online a 4-5 minute radio drama on the given stimuli. In the preparation of their radio dramas, teams are strongly encouraged to use improvisation techniques.
- 4. There are two categories for the competition, a '1-day' category and a '2-week' category. In the "1-day" category, which adds a higher level of challenge to the competition, students are given 90 minutes to create, without teacher supervision, a radio drama and then perform it live with online video conferencing. In the '2-week' category, students will be given approximately 14 calendar days to create a radio drama under the supervision of their teacher. In addition to the 4 to 6 performers, up to 4 other students may be involved to help prepare for the performance (in capacity as a director, writer or deviser).
- 5. The competition is open to local secondary schools in Hong Kong. Interested schools should submit the entry form by email by 24 October 2022 (Monday). Please refer to Appendix 3a for the competition timeline and Appendix 3b for the poster. 

"Library Cards for All School Children" Scheme

Bulk Application for Library Cards of the Hong Kong Public Libraries or Using Smart Identity Cards as Identity Cards Allowed for Library Purposes

Aims/Purpose

This is to inform kindergartens and primary schools of the "Library Cards for All School Children" scheme and the arrangement of bulk application for library cards of the Hong Kong Public Libraries or using Smart Identity Cards as identity cards allowed for library purposes for **Kindergarten and Primary 1 to 6 students**.

Details

- 2. In this digital era and knowledge-based society, we need to help our students equip themselves with the necessary skills to cope with the demands. Students are not only expected to have considerable experiences in and a passion for reading, but also to master "Reading to Learn" skills, that help enhance their learning capacity leading to life-long learning and whole-person development. Hence, students should fully utilise services and facilities provided by the school libraries as well as the Hong Kong Public Libraries.
- 3. The Education Bureau and the Leisure and Cultural Services Department jointly organised the "Library Cards for All School Children" scheme to encourage students to make full use of services provided by the Hong Kong Public Libraries. Schools should encourage their students to apply for Hong Kong Public Libraries library cards or using Smart Identity Cards as identity cards allowed for library purposes.
- 4. Methods of application for Hong Kong Public Libraries library cards or using Smart Identity Cards as identity cards allowed for library purposes are as follows:

(a) <u>Direct Application</u>

Students may visit any public libraries with their parents to apply for and receive library cards / library card numbers for Smart Identity Cards directly. Applicants and their parents should present supporting documents showing their residential addresses and personal identifications.

(b) Online Application

Through the new Hong Kong Public Libraries Online Registration of Borrowers platform, students can make online application for

- (i) E-Accounts, or
- (ii) using Smart Identity Cards as identity cards allowed for library purposes and / or library cards.

Upon submission of valid application, students using Hong Kong Smart Identity Card for application can login immediately through the website of Hong Kong Public Libraries, and borrow e-books or enjoy access to diversified e-resources. For details about online application, please refer to the website of the Hong Kong Public Libraries (https://www.hkpl.gov.hk/en/about-us/services/borrower-reg/notes.html).



(c) Bulk Application through Schools

Students may also apply through bulk application at schools. Under normal circumstances, library cards / library card numbers for Smart Identity Cards will be issued in about **a month**. Please refer to **Appendix 16a** for details.

The Hong Kong Public Libraries of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department provides public library services to meet the community's need for knowledge, information and research, to support life-long learning, continuous education and profitable use of leisure time, and to promote local literary arts. The "Library Cards for All School Children" scheme is jointly organised by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department Hong Kong Public Libraries and the Education Bureau. It aims to encourage school students to use public library resources to facilitate life-long learning.

Application Procedures for Bulk Application for Library Cards of the Hong Kong Public Libraries or Using Smart Identity Cards as Identity Cards Allowed for Library Purposes

1. Collection of Application Forms

Teachers-in-charge may contact the Librarians / Assistant Librarians of the branch libraries in their districts for collection of application forms (please refer to **Appendix 16b** for contacts of the branch libraries). Students may apply for "library cards" or "using Smart Identity Cards as identity cards allowed for library purposes". Those applying for the latter must possess valid Smart Identity Cards. For application of "library cards", please refer to the application form at **Appendix 16c(i)**. For application of "using Smart Identity Cards as identity cards allowed for library purposes", please refer to the application form at **Appendix 16c(ii)**. Schools may also download the application forms from the web site of Hong Kong Public Libraries (https://www.hkpl.gov.hk/en/common/attachments/about-us/forms/LCS4.pdf and http://www.hkpl.gov.hk/en/common/attachments/about-us/forms/LCS694.pdf). Students may use Form No. **LCS 4** to apply for "library cards" or Form No. **LCS 694** to apply for "using Smart Identity Cards as identity cards allowed for library purposes".

2. Return of Duly Completed Application Forms

Procedures for collecting application forms:

- i. separate application forms of "library cards" from the application of "using Smart Identity Cards as identity cards allowed for library purposes"*.
- ii. check the application forms for the following:
 - a. If the students have provided all necessary information on the application forms;
 - b. If the students have signed the application forms; and
 - c. If the part 'Guarantee' is duly completed and have included signatures of their parents/guardians.
- iii. stamp all verified application forms with school chop.
- iv. return the completed <u>application forms</u>, <u>reply slip(s)</u> and <u>name list(s)</u> of students (to be grouped separately under "library cards" and "using Smart Identity Cards as identity cards allowed for library purposes" *) to the Librarians / Assistant Librarians of the branch libraries in their districts.

Please refer to the attached samples and guidelines on filling in the application forms (Appendix 16c(i) and Appendix 16c(ii)) for reference.

3. Collection of Library Cards / Library Card Numbers for Smart Identity Cards, and leaflets of notes on library services and regulations

Library cards / library card numbers for Smart Identity Cards[#] will generally be issued in <u>about a month</u> after the application. Teachers-in-charge will be informed of the arrangement for the collection of library cards / library card numbers for Smart Identity Cards, leaflets introducing library services and summary of Libraries Regulation for onward transmission to students concerned.

4. Deadline

The deadline of bulk application is 30 June 2023 (Friday).

SUMMARY OF LIBRARIES REGULATION (GOVERNING THE USE OF THE PUBLIC LIBRARIES)

(Note: In the event of inconsistency between this Summary and the full-text version of the Regulation, the full-text version shall prevail. The complete set of <u>Libraries Regulation</u> can be consulted on request at any public libraries.)

- 1. "Borrower" means the holder of a library card or an identity card allowed for library purposes.
- 2. A person who wishes to use his identity card with embodied chip as an identity card allowed for library purposes shall complete an application form supplied by the librarian.
- 3. All library materials borrowed from a library shall be returned to the library within 14 days after the day upon which it was borrowed.
- 4. Unless already reserved by another reader, each loan item may be renewed for up to five consecutive times with a period of 14 days from the date of each renewal.
- 5. An overdue fine is imposed on each loan item and accompanying library material returned late. The charge is \$1.5 per day or part of a day for each loan item or accompanying library material borrowed from an adult library and \$0.5 for that borrowed from a young adult or children's library.
- 6. A borrower may borrow a maximum of eight library items together with accompanying library materials or 16 back issues of periodicals.
- 7. A borrower shall not lend or transfer his library card or identity card allowed for library purposes to any other person.
- 8. A borrower shall forthwith report to the librarian in writing the loss of his library card or identity card allowed for library purposes.
- 9. The following fees shall be payable on every issue of replacement library card: a. \$33 for borrowers aged 18 or above (including "Library Card for Guarantor's Use"); and
 - b. \$17 for borrowers aged under 18.
- 10. In case of loss of his identity card allowed for library purposes, a borrower may apply to use his replacement identity card with embodied chip as an identity card allowed for library purposes, and such application is free of charge.
- 11. Unless a borrower has reported in writing loss of his library card or identity card allowed for library purposes, he shall be held responsible for any library material borrowed under the card.

- 12. A reservation fee of \$3.3 is charged per item (or the prevailing valid reservation fee at the time of collection).
- 13. A library card or an identity card allowed for library purposes can be used at any of the libraries under the HKPL.
- 14. Except with the permission of the librarian or when accompanied by an adult, a person under 12 years of age shall not enter or use the adult library and the reference library therein.
- 15. A borrower shall, before leaving the library, ensure that the library material issued to him on loan is complete and undamaged.
- 16. If any library material borrowed is lost or damaged, the borrower shall be liable to pay to the Government such sum of money as the librarian considers necessary to replace such library material or the whole set of library material of which such library material forms a part. In addition, the borrower may be required to pay a surcharge amounting to 20 per cent of such sum.
- 17. A borrower may apply to cancel his library card or discontinue the use of his identity card with embodied chip as an identity card allowed for library purposes.
- 18. If an applicant is under 18 years of age, the guarantor should be his/her parent (father or mother) or guardian. If his/her parent or guardian is unable to become the guarantor for whatever reasons, the applicant should ask an adult resident of Hong Kong to act as his/her guarantor. The guarantor shall be liable for all liabilities incurred by the applicant under Sections 21, 27 or 28 of the Libraries Regulation.

Remarks:

A borrower shall <u>notify the librarian in writing</u> of any change in his/her residential address as soon as practicable.

Junior Secondary Science Online Self-learning Scheme 2023

Aims

This is to invite secondary schools to nominate Secondary 1-3 students to participate in the captioned Scheme.

Details

- 2. To facilitate the promotion of STEAM education, the Education Bureau has all along been enhancing the implementation of Science (S1-3) curriculum, with a view to building a solid foundation of science knowledge among students, strengthening their abilities on scientific investigation as well as enhancing their interests in learning science. In tandem, we also promote the use of technology in learning and teaching, including the use of e-learning learning platform for promoting self-directed learning among students.
- 3. "Junior Secondary Science Online Self-learning Scheme (JSSOSS) 2023" is organised by the Education Bureau, and supported by the Hong Kong Virtual University of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. The Scheme aims to cultivate students' interest in science, to encourage students to take initiative to learn and pursue the latest science knowledge, as well as to enhance students' scientific literacy through online self-learning activities. To enhance students' experiences on e-learning, the science learning activities in the Scheme will further be enriched starting from this year; in addition to science online seminars of different topics and electronic quizzes, science online reading activities will also be included. The contents of these learning activities are relevant to Science (S1-3) curriculum. The e-learning platform will adopt a new interactive interface to facilitate students in participating the learning activities more easily. To encourage students to participate in the Scheme, certificates will be awarded to students participating in the Scheme according to their performance in the online learning activities.
- 4. The Scheme will be held **from 1 January 2023 to 31 March 2023**. All Secondary 1-3 students are welcome to participate in the Scheme. Participants should apply via schools. Only one application form is needed for each school. 
