"2023 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" Programme

Summary

This circular memorandum aims to invite schools to take part in the "2023 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" Programme jointly organised by the Education Bureau (EDB) and the Security Bureau (SB).

Background

2. In the 2021/22 school year, the EDB and the SB jointly organised the "Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" Programme for the first time. With strong support from schools to encourage active participation of students, the two key activities, namely "2022 National Security Online Quiz Competition" and "2022 Slogan-cum-Poster Design Competition on National Security", were well-

received. Apart from being uploaded to the Hong Kong National Security Law online virtual exhibition, some of the winning entries have also been adopted in the 2022/23 School Year Calendar for the Promotion of National



Education and National Security Education (Chinese version only) for schools to download and use. To enable national security education to continuously take roots in schools and to complement the National Security Education Day on 15 April 2023, the EDB and the SB continue to jointly organise the "2023 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" Programme in the 2022/23 school year to engage teachers and students in Hong Kong to raise their awareness of national security, create a positive atmosphere of safeguarding national security, enhance their understanding of the Constitution, the Basic Law and national security and unite the efforts in safeguarding national security.

Details

3. The EDB and the SB have designed a series of activities for the "2023 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" Programme covering the whole school year to strengthen the atmosphere of national security education in schools. Schools can encourage and arrange for students to participate in one or more of the activities below, including:

- i). "2023 Slogan-cum-Poster Design Competition on National Security" (Annex 1)
- ii). "2023 National Security Online Quiz Competition" (Annex 2)
- iii). "2023 National Security Writing Competition" (Annex 3)
- iv). "2023 School Bulletin Board Design Competition on National Security" (Annex 4)

4. To facilitate schools in understanding the activities of the "2023 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" Programme, the EDB will organise online briefing sessions on October 25 and 26 this year to introduce the details and the specifics of the activities of the "2023 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" Programme. For details of the online briefing sessions and the registration methods, please refer to **Annex 5**.

5. The EDB will continue to provide a wide variety of resources related to

Constitution, Basic Law and national security education through the webbased resource platform "National Education One-stop Portal" (www.edb.gov.hk/en/neosp) to help schools promote national education and national security education, cultivate in students a sense of national identity,



as well as an awareness of and a sense of responsibility for safeguarding national security. Schools can also encourage students to study reference materials and websites related to national security education (**Annex 6**) and refer to other suitable reference materials and websites in preparation for the competitions.

Annex 1

2023 Slogan-cum-Poster Design Competition on National Security

Objectives

The competition aims to encourage students to uphold positive values and demonstrate their understanding of national security in a creative and artistic way through writing slogans and designing posters on the theme of national security. Schools can also make use of the entries to promote activities related to national security education on campus and in the community.

Eligibility

- Primary Section: Primary 1-6 students
- Secondary Section: Secondary 1-6 students

Topics

- Primary Section: "The Close Relationship between National Security and Our Daily Lives"
 - Write a slogan and produce a poster in one of the following areas on the topic
 "The Close Relationship between National Security and Our Daily Lives":
 - ♦ The Hong Kong National Security Law makes our lives better
 - The relationship between one or more of the domains of national security¹ and various aspects of our daily lives
 - ♦ Encouraging classmates to join hands in safeguarding national security
 - The slogan designed for each entry shall match the above topic and the content of the poster.

• Secondary Section: "The Hong Kong National Security Law Maintains Prosperity and Stability of Hong Kong"

Write a slogan and produce a poster in one of the following areas to demonstrate the importance of national security to individuals, our society and our country on the topic "The Hong Kong National Security Law Maintains Prosperity and

¹According to the "Curriculum Framework of National Security Education in Hong Kong", the domains of national security include political security, homeland security, military security, economic security, cultural security, social security, technological security, cyber security, ecological security, resource security, nuclear security, overseas interests security and new security domains (including biosecurity, space security, deep sea security, polar security).

Stability of Hong Kong":

- The Hong Kong National Security Law ensures the prosperity and stability of Hong Kong
- The Hong Kong National Security Law ensures the steadfast and successful implementation of the principle of "one country, two systems"
- Encouraging young people to join hands in safeguarding national security
- The slogan designed for each entry shall match the selected area and the content of the poster.

Mode of Entry

- Students should enter the competition on an individual basis, and each student can only submit one entry.
- Each student should be coached by one teacher, and each teacher may coach more than one student.
- There is no limit on the number of entries submitted by each school.

Competition Rules

Requirements for entries:

- Students are required to produce posters in two dimensions. There are no restrictions on the format and materials.
- Entries must be a graphic design with colours in A3 size (297 mm x 420 mm) and can be hand-drawn or computer-designed.
- Entries must be presented in Chinese and/or English.
- The content of the entries should not reveal information related to the participating schools and students.
- Entries should be converted into electronic files for submission.
- The resolution of the electronic files should be no less than 300dpi.

Points to Note on the Use of the National Flag, National Emblem, Regional Flag, Regional Emblem and their Designs in Design Competitions:

• If the use of the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem and their designs is needed in the entries, participants shall abide by the National Flag and National Emblem Ordinance and the Regional Flag and Regional Emblem Ordinance, and observe the following requirements:

- The shape, design and colour of the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem or their designs used in the competition should be identical to the national flag, national emblem, regional flag or regional emblem commonly in use, e.g. design in the form of a jigsaw puzzle is not allowed.
- Any text or symbol should not be overlapped with the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem or their designs.
- Respect should be given when the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem or their designs are used. Misunderstanding by the public that the designs of the entries do not respect the national flag, national emblem, regional flag and regional emblem should also be avoided. Common irregularities found in designs (not exhaustive) include:
 - \diamond not all five stars of the national flag are shown
 - \diamond the bauhinia design is tilted
 - ♦ the flag/emblem is partially covered
 - \diamond the flag/emblem is defaced
 - \diamond the direction of the flag/emblem is reversed
- Regarding the specifications for the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem and the points to note, please refer to the National Flag and National Emblem Ordinance, the Regional Flag and Regional Emblem Ordinance and the related websites (Please refer to Annex 6 for the relevant web links).

Points to Note on the Use of the Map of the Territory of the People's Republic of China:

• If the use of the map of the territory of the People's Republic of China is needed in the entries, participants should ensure the correct map of the territory is used. For details, please refer to the following website:

• If any entry fails to comply with the above requirements on the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem and map of the territory of the People's Republic of China, the participant may be requested to make amendments to the design or the entry may be disqualified (without prior notice).

• Schools should duly complete the entry form online and upload the electronic files of the entries (must be in BMP/ JPEG/ PDF/ PNG/ TIFF format) via the following websites or QR codes <u>on or before 20 January 2023 (Friday)</u>.

Judging Criteria

- Content of slogan and poster (50%)
- Creative design (30%)
- Artistic skill (20%)

Adjudication Panel

- Entries will be adjudicated by a panel comprising members of the Curriculum Development Council, Curriculum Development Council Standing Committee on Values Education, the EDB and the SB.
- The adjudication panel reserves the right of final decision on the competition.

Awards

- The following awards will be given to each section:
 - > Individual awards: First, Second and Third Prizes, and Honourable Mentions
 - > "2023 Slogan-cum-Poster Design Competition on National Security:

Outstanding Slogan Award": The award will be given to the student with the best slogan in each section.

- "2023 Slogan-cum-Poster Design Competition on National Security: Active Participation School Award": The award will be given to the 10 schools with the highest number of participating students in each section.
- Outstanding English Entry Award
- Winning schools will each receive a trophy, while winning students will each receive a certificate and a prize.
- Students who have participated in the "Basic Law Student Ambassadors Training Scheme" organised by the EDB and can successfully submit their entries for this competition will be awarded one point. Those who win an individual award in this competition will be awarded one extra point.

Use of Winning Entries

- Winning entries of individual awards may be developed into banners for school display and publicity.
- Participating and winning entries may be used for promotional purposes by the EDB and the SB.
- Participating and winning entries may be uploaded to the websites and social media platforms of the EDB and the SB.
- The EDB recommends schools to upload participating and winning entries to their school websites for viewing by parents and the public.

Points to Note for Schools

- The EDB reserves the right to change, suspend or terminate the activity at any time. If there are any changes, announcements will be made on the EDB's "National Education One-stop Portal".
- The EDB reserves the right to change the competition awards without prior notice.
- Once an entry is submitted, it cannot be modified, re-uploaded or returned.
- Participating schools should keep the original posters until the end of this school year.
- The entry submission date and time will be based on the date and time indicated in the EDB's server system.
- Participating schools should ensure that information and content included in their entries are in line with the curriculum aims and objectives set out by the EDB, contain no element of obscenity, abuse, violence, defamation, endangerment to national security, etc., and do not violate the laws of the HKSAR. Otherwise, the participants will be disqualified.
- All entries (including every part of an entry) must be the participants' original works, and not have been released publicly. They must not infringe copyrights or interests of any other party; otherwise the participants will be held responsible for any disputes arising therefrom and may be disqualified from the competition. If necessary, the EDB may request the participants to produce written proof of legal authorisation.
- The EDB reserves the right to reject or disqualify any entries without giving particular reasons.
- The EDB reserves the right to use the participants' works (including school names) in whole or in part for non-profit-making purposes, and to edit, translate, adapt, use, copy, distribute and upload the entries to the Internet without prior consent of the participants.

2023 National Security Online Quiz Competition

Objectives

The competition aims to enhance students' understanding of the Constitution, the Basic Law and national security, the rule of law and the development of our country, the importance of safeguarding national security, the close relationship between national security and our daily lives, as well as the importance of national security to individuals, our society and our country.

Eligibility

- Primary Section: Primary 1-6 students
- Secondary Section: Secondary 1-6 students

Details

- The competition will be held in the form of an online quiz, and there is no limit on the number of participants from each school. Participation by all students is encouraged.
- Participating students should enter the competition by logging into the following website using their Hong Kong Education City accounts from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.² during the period from 14 April (Friday) to 26 April (Wednesday) 2023.
- Schools may make arrangement for students to participate in the competition all at the same time or in batches. It is also possible for students to participate in the competition at home.

 - Individual awards: The awards include First, Second and Third Prizes, and Honourable Mentions (based on the number of questions correctly answered). In case of a tie, the total time used in answering the questions will be compared in deciding which student(s) will receive the award(s).
- A certificate will be awarded to each participating school and student.
- Students who have participated in the "Basic Law Student Ambassadors Training Scheme" organised by the EDB and entered this online quiz competition successfully will be awarded one point. Those who win an individual award in this competition will be awarded one extra point.
- Winning schools/students may be invited to join additional activity(ies) under the "2023 Let's Join Hands in Safeguarding National Security" Programme.

<u>Entry</u>

- Schools interested in entering the "2023 National Security Online Quiz Competition" should log into Hong Kong Education City by accessing its website (www.edcity.hk/national-security/reg) with their principal, teacher or school administrator accounts, follow the instructions thereon and submit a completed entry form (Chinese version only) from 21 March (Tuesday) to 11 April (Tuesday) 2023. Schools that fail to complete the entry procedures before the deadline will be disqualified and their results in the competition, if any, will not be admitted.
- The information submitted by schools will be used for the "2023 National Security Online Quiz Competition". Participating schools should ensure that all information provided is correct before submitting the entry form. Provision of incorrect information may affect their eligibility for entering the competition and results.
- Schools should confirm that their students' accounts with the Hong Kong Education City have been renewed for the current school year prior to the submission of an entry form, and inform their students of the account information accordingly before the competition. Schools may work out the arrangement with their teachers in charge or information technology co-ordinators. If further assistance is required, schools may approach the Hong Kong Education City.

Annex 3

2023 National Security Writing Competition

Objectives

The competition aims to enhance students' understanding of the development of our country and national security, and cultivate in students a sense of belonging to our country by writing down their feelings and thoughts after watching videos on the theme of "national security" and reading related books. Schools can also make use of the entries for school-based activities related to national security education to create a positive atmosphere for safeguarding national security together on campus.

Eligibility/Word Count

<u>Participating students can write in either Chinese or English. Word count of the</u> entry should not be less than the numbers listed below:

- Lower Primary Section (Primary 1-3 students): 100 words (in Chinese) or 40 words (in English)
- Upper Primary Section (Primary 4-6 students): 150 words (in Chinese) or 80 words (in English)
- Junior Secondary Section (Secondary 1-3 students): 250 words (in Chinese) or 150 words (in English)
- Senior Secondary Section (Secondary 4-6 students): 450 words (in Chinese) or 300 words (in English)

Topics

- Participating students should watch the following videos/read the following books according to their respective section, and then express their feelings and thoughts in writing on the theme of safeguarding national security. The content may include but not limited to:
 - how the videos/books enhance the participants' understanding of safeguarding national security;
 - how the videos/books are related to various aspects of an individual's daily life; and
 - how the videos/books strengthen their awareness of and sense of responsibility for safeguarding national security.

- Students can choose one item as the source materials for their writing, or more than one item for an integrated writing, and give a title to the writing.
- To demonstrate their creativity, students can add art designs including images and decorations to complement their writings.

- Entries should be converted into electronic files for submission.

2023 School Bulletin Board Design Competition on National Security

Objectives

The competition aims to encourage students to be creative in designing school bulletin boards on the theme of "national security", and enhance students' understanding of national security, the close relationship between national security and our daily lives, and the importance of safeguarding national security to individuals, our society and our

country. Schools may refer to the important dates listed in the "National Education – Event Planning Calendar" published earlier by the EDB, including the "Commemoration Day for the Promulgation of the Basic Law" on April 4 and the "National Security Education Day" on April 15,



to create a positive atmosphere in class and the whole school to safeguard national security through the design of school bulletin boards.

Eligibility

- Primary Section: Primary 1-6 students
- Secondary Section: Secondary 1-6 students

Topics

- Primary Section: "National Security and Our Lives"
 - Make a school/ classroom bulletin board in one of the following areas to show the close relationship between national security and our daily lives:
 - The close relationship among one or more of the domains of national security³ and various aspects of our daily lives
 - ♦ Safeguarding national security requires our joint effort
- Secondary Section: "Joining Hands in Safeguarding National Security Enables Hong Kong to Undergo the Transition from Stability to Prosperity"
 - Make a school/ classroom bulletin board in one of the following areas to demonstrate the importance of national security to social and national development:

³According to the "Curriculum Framework of National Security Education in Hong Kong", the domains of national security include political security, homeland security, military security, economic security, cultural security, social security, technological security, cyber security, ecological security, resource security, nuclear security, overseas interests security and new security domains (including biosecurity, space security, deep sea security, polar security).

- The Hong Kong National Security Law ensures the steadfast and successful implementation of the principle of "one country, two systems"
- The interconnection between one or more of the domains of national security⁴ and the benefits of Hong Kong residents

Mode of Entry

- Students should enter the competition on a team basis. Each team should have a minimum of three and a maximum of six members, and one of them should serve as the team leader.
- Each student can only join one team, and each team can only submit one entry.
- Each team should be coached by one teacher, and each teacher may coach more than one team.
- There is no limit on the number of entries submitted by each school.

Competition Rules

Participating teams are required to select a topic area under the themes of their respective section to make a bulletin board, and submit a short video or a brief description explaining the key ideas and features of the board.

Requirements for entries:

- A bulletin board can be made in two or three dimensions according to the size of the board. There are no restrictions on the format and materials.
- If an entry contains texts, such texts should be in Chinese and/or English.
- Participating teams are required to take **no more than five photos** of the bulletin board, including one photo showing the full view of the bulletin board, and submit the photos in the form of electronic files. The resolution of the photos should be no less than 300dpi.
- A description of no more than 200 words (punctuation marks are not counted) written in Chinese/English, or a short video not exceeding 2 minutes explaining the key ideas and features of the bulletin board shall be provided for each entry. The resolution of the video must be 720p or above.

Points to Note on the Use of the National Flag, National Emblem, Regional Flag, Regional Emblem and their Designs in Design Competitions:

• If the use of the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem and their designs is needed in the entries, participants shall abide by the National

Flag and National Emblem Ordinance and the Regional Flag and Regional Emblem Ordinance, and observe the following requirements:

- The shape, design and colour of the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem or their designs used in the competition should be identical to the national flag, national emblem, regional flag or regional emblem commonly in use, e.g. design in the form of a jigsaw puzzle is not allowed.
- Any text or symbol should not be overlapped with the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem or their designs.
- Respect should be given when the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem or their designs are used. Misunderstanding by the public that the designs of the entries do not respect the national flag, national emblem, regional flag and regional emblem should also be avoided. Common irregularities found in designs (not exhaustive) include:
 - \diamond not all five stars of the national flag are shown
 - \diamond the bauhinia design is tilted
 - ♦ the flag/emblem is partially covered
 - \diamond the flag/emblem is defaced
 - \diamondsuit the direction of the flag/emblem is reversed
- Regarding the specifications for the national flag, national emblem, regional flag, regional emblem and the points to note, please refer to the National Flag and National Emblem Ordinance, the Regional Flag and Regional Emblem Ordinance and the related websites (Please refer to Annex 6 for the relevant web links).

Points to Note on the Use of the Map of the Territory of the People's Republic of China:

• If the use of the map of the territory of the People's Republic of China is needed in the entries, participants should ensure the correct map of the territory is used. For details, please refer to the following website:
