(Note: This Circular Memorandum should be read by Supervisors, Heads and Newly-joined Teachers of all government schools, aided schools (including special schools), caput schools and schools under the Direct Subsidy Scheme.)

### **Training Requirements for Newly-joined Teachers**

#### **Summary**

This circular memorandum aims to elaborate on the training requirements for newly-joined teachers (hereafter 'NJTs'), and remind schools to closely monitor the training progress of NJTs. The circular memorandum should be read together with Education Bureau Circular No. 6/2020 "Implementation of the Recommendations of the Task Force on Professional Development of Teachers".

#### Training requirements for Newly-joined Teachers

- 2. The Education Bureau (EDB) implemented the recommendations of the Task Force on Professional Development of Teachers and established the Professional Ladder for Teachers in Hong Kong. With the prevailing Continuing Professional Development (CPD) policy for teachers¹ remaining unchanged, a training framework was set up for teachers. Starting from the 2020/21 school year, full-time teachers appointed to teach in public sector schools (including government, aided and caput schools) or schools under the Direct Subsidy Scheme for the first time are required to complete 30 hours of core training and not less than 60 hours of elective training based on individual professional development needs within the first three years of service.
- 3. Core training is offered by EDB, which comprises two categories. Details are as follows:

The number of CPD hours is a "soft target" designed to encourage teachers to participate in CPD activities.

4. For elective training, NJTs can participate in structured programmes/activities, according to their individual professional development needs, such as professional development programmes related to Key Learning Areas/subjects and fostering of students' whole-person development, school sponsoring body/school-based induction programmes for NJTs, etc.. Structured learning also includes local/non-local education conferences, seminars, thematic lectures, workshops and local and non-local study tours. Teachers should keep the training records properly, and register information about elective training courses which are not enrolled through EDB Training Calendar System on the e-Services Portal (https://eservices.edb.gov.hk) in order to facilitate schools' monitoring and follow-up.

## Schools' Monitoring and Follow-up

5. Schools should perform their role of monitoring and support by regularly reviewing all NJTs' training progress, reminding and arranging them to complete the core and elective training, and reporting to the School Management Committee (SMC)/Incorporated Management Committee (IMC)/school governance authorities regularly. When schools update teachers' personal profiles for the 2023/24 school year<sup>2</sup>, they must ensure the information of NJTs is accurate, for example, their first appointment year, and pay attention to their training periods. Please refer to the Annex for procedures for viewing the NJTs' training progress.

#### Follow-up on the Training Progress of NJTs of the 2020/21 School Year

6. In principle, NJTs of the 2020/21 school year should meet the training requirements by the end of the 2022/23 school year, and schools should keep the records properly. If there are NJTs of the 2020/21 school year who have not completed or enrolled in core training programmes, schools must take stringent follow-up actions, including (i) requesting them to enrol in incomplete core training programmes as soon

as practicable; (ii) requesting those who have neither completed the Mainland Study Tours nor attended the Thematic Talks between 18 and 20 July 2023 to enrol in the make-up sessions of the Thematic Talks; and/or (iii) participate in the **three-day Mainland Study Tours** afterwards. The make-up sessions of the Thematic Talks are now available on EDB Training Calendar System for enrolment with details as follows:

7. Teachers should actively participate in continuous professional development activities to enhance their professional competence and meet the training requirements at different stages of profession in accordance with the guidelines of EDB and their schools<sup>3</sup>. Please be reminded that if the teachers concerned have not yet enrolled in the core training programmes (category 1) and the make-up sessions of the Thematic Talks by 6 October 2023, EDB will write to SMC/IMC/school governance authorities of individual schools and request explanation and follow-up actions.

8. EDB has been launching the aforementioned core training programmes for NJTs from time to time. 
### **Procedures for Viewing the Training Progress of NJTs**

#### **Schools**

Log on to EDB e-Services Portal (<a href="https://eservices.edb.gov.hk">https://eservices.edb.gov.hk</a>) and select "Training Programme for Newly-joined Teachers" under "Professional Ladder for Teachers".



2. View the list of NJTs, their "First Appointment Date in Public Sector or DSS School" and "Completed Hours of Training Programme for NJTs". If teachers are not appointed as a full-time teacher to teach in public sector schools or schools under the Direct Subsidy Scheme for the first time in the 2020/21 school year or later, they will not be included in the list.



3. Tick the box(es) of individual teacher(s) and click "Search" to view their training details, including course names and end dates of the courses.



#### **NJTs**

1. Log on to EDB e-Services Portal (<a href="https://eservices.edb.gov.hk">https://eservices.edb.gov.hk</a>) and select "Training Programme for Newly-joined Teachers" under "Professional Ladder for Teachers". If teachers are not appointed as a full-time teacher to teach in public sector schools or schools under the Direct Subsidy Scheme for the first time in the 2020/21 school year or later, the relevant item will not be displayed.



2. View the details of core and elective training completed, including end dates of the courses and training hours. Each core training course should be taken once only. For repeated enrolment, no CPD hours will be awarded.
