School-based Support Services (2024/25)

Summary

The purpose of this circular memorandum (CM) is to invite kindergartens/kindergarten-cum-child care centres and schools with kindergarten classes (collectively referred to as “kindergartens” hereafter), primary, secondary, and special schools (collectively referred to as “schools” hereafter) to apply for the school-based support services (SBSS) offered by the Education Bureau (EDB) in the 2024/25 school year (s.y.).

Background

2. EDB has been offering diversified SBSS to kindergartens and schools with a view to enhancing the professional capabilities of school curriculum leadership and teaching teams in implementing the curriculum, facilitating schools to align their school curriculum with curriculum initiatives, as well as carrying out and deepening various implementation strategies in pursuit of quality education. The personnel providing SBSS include officers from EDB, tertiary institutions, frontline teachers from schools, and Mainland expert teachers.

Details

Support Service Categories

3. The scope of SBSS is extensive, encompassing various Key Learning Areas (KLAs) or subjects as well as in line with the latest curriculum initiatives, including national education, values education, STEAM education, understanding Chinese culture and catering for learning diversity, to provide students with comprehensive and quality learning experiences. There are two major categories of SBSS:

- (a) Professional support services provided by EDB officers or Mainland expert teachers (“Mainland–Hong Kong Teacher Exchange and Collaboration Programme”); and

- (b) On-site support services funded by the Quality Education Fund, provided by tertiary institutes or schools, which include (i) “Quality Education Fund Thematic Networks – Tertiary Institutes (QTN–T)”, (ii) “Quality Education Fund Thematic Networks – Schools (QTN–S)”, and (iii) “Quality Education Fund Thematic Networks (QTNs)” (including “The Pioneering Programme of Primary Science Education”).

Support Service Modes

4. Various modes of SBSS are available to accommodate the needs of kindergartens and schools.

(a) On-site Support

- The support team will conduct regular school visits based on schools’ development and needs, engage in professional collaborative activities such as collaborative lesson planning, lesson observations, and post-lesson discussions with teachers, as well as collaborating with the teaching team to review and develop the school curriculum in accordance with the Hong Kong School Curriculum Framework.
- Participating schools must appoint curriculum leaders to lead the teaching team to take part in the professional support service. In addition to developing the school curriculum, the teaching team should also actively participate in inter-school professional development activities to share and promote effective practices and resources so as to foster professional exchanges among schools.

(b) Learning Communities

- The support team will establish a sharing platform that encourages curriculum leaders from participating schools to share their experiences, views and insights on topics of mutual concern, exploring effective learning and teaching strategies with a view to facilitating professional exchanges among schools and enhancing teachers’ professional capacity.
- Participating schools must appoint at least one coordinating teacher to liaise with the support team and arrange teachers to participate in related collaborative and professional development activities. Participating teachers should actively engage in discussions and sharing, and take the learning outcomes back to their schools for developing the school curriculum in alignment with curriculum initiatives to enhance the quality of education.

Key Areas of Support

5. EDB will further strengthen SBSS by enhancing the linkages between various KLAs/subjects and curriculum initiatives, and facilitate more inter-school professional exchanges, and provide appropriate and diversified professional support services for schools.

The key areas of support are as follows:

(a) Strengthening linkages with curriculum initiatives

In addition to promoting the implementation of the curricula in different KLAs/subjects, linkages between SBSS and curriculum initiatives, including national education, values education, STEAM education, and Chinese culture, will also be strengthened to enhance the effectiveness of schools in implementing related cross-curricular projects (the curriculum initiatives linked to each support service are listed with a # in **Annexes A to C**).

(b) Strengthening support for school curriculum leadership

Support for school curriculum leadership will be enhanced to improve their professional capacity in curriculum planning in areas such as early childhood education, primary science education and Chinese language, and in leading their school teams to develop a distinctive and effective school curriculum in alignment with curriculum initiatives.

(c) Optimising the mode of support and enhancing dissemination

Inter-school exchange platforms will be enhanced to promote professional discussions and sharing on topics of mutual concern among schools, and facilitate further dissemination of experiences so that more schools can benefit.

(d) Optimising the “Mainland–Hong Kong Teachers Exchange and Collaboration Programme (MHKTECP)”

Leveraging the expertise of Mainland expert teachers, MHKTECP will roll out more interdisciplinary projects, such as STEAM education, Chinese culture and virtues, and primary science education, to optimise the effectiveness of exchange and collaboration.

Application Arrangements

6. The application for the following support services must be processed through the “Online Application System (OAS) for School-based Support Services (SBSS)”, which can be accessed via the “Common Log-on System” (CLO) (<https://clo.edb.gov.hk>) of EDB (Please refer to **Annexes A to C** for details of the support services):

- (a) Professional support services provided by EDB officers or Mainland expert teachers;
- (b) Professional support services under the “Quality Education Fund Thematic Networks – Tertiary Institutes (QTN–T)” and “Quality Education Fund Thematic Networks – Schools (QTN–S)”; and
- (c) “Quality Education Fund Thematic Networks (QTNs): The Pioneering Programme of Primary Science Education”

7. In addition, EDB provides on-site support services for schools on Information Technology (IT) in education and e-learning through “IT in Education Centre of Excellence

(CoE) Scheme”. For application arrangements related to the “IT in Education Centre of Excellence (CoE) Scheme” and other “Quality Education Fund Thematic Networks (QTNs)”, please register with the Information Technology in Education Section of EDB and the coordinating organisations of the QTNs respectively. For details, please refer to **Annexes D and E**.

8. Kindergartens and schools interested in applying for the above services should conduct a comprehensive review of their development and needs before selecting the most suitable support services. Each kindergarten and school may apply for a maximum of two school-based support services. To foster professional exchanges and collaboration between the Mainland and local teachers, step up the support for kindergartens and schools admitting non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) children/students and strengthen curriculum leadership in primary schools, kindergartens and schools may additionally apply for “recommended services” item, including (i) “Mainland–Hong Kong Teachers Exchange and Collaboration Programme”, (ii) support services for kindergartens/schools admitting NCS children/students, and (iii) “Learning Community for Primary School Master/Mistress (Curriculum Development) [PSM(CD)]: Promoting Curriculum Initiatives and Developing Curriculum Leadership” (each “recommended service” item is marked with an asterisk (*) at the beginning of the service title).

9. Kindergartens and schools¹ may apply for the relevant support services from **22 March 2024 to 30 April 2024**. Allocation results will be announced on **21 June 2024** via the OAS. For more information about individual support service, please visit the SBSS website of EDB (URL: <https://www.edb.gov.hk/sbss>).

10. EDB will organise an online briefing session on **9 April 2024** to introduce the arrangements of various support services. There will be a Question & Answer session for support officers to address schools’ enquiries about the services. The course numbers of the briefing sessions are as follows:
