Hong Kong Reading for All Day –

Hong Kong Reading for All Day – Joint Primary and Secondary School 30-minute Read

Summary

This circular invites all primary and secondary schools (including special schools) that offer local curriculum to participate in the captioned activity.

Details

- 2. The Education Bureau (EDB) has always been committed to assisting schools in promoting reading. To echo the first Hong Kong Reading for All Day which will be held on 23 April, 2024, the Curriculum Development Institute of the EDB and the Hong Kong Public Libraries (HKPL) of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) jointly organise the 'Hong Kong Reading for All Day Joint Primary and Secondary School 30-minute Read'. All primary and secondary schools are invited to join the captioned activity for boosting students' interest in reading and fostering the reading atmosphere on campus.
- 3. The 45-minute opening ceremony of 'Hong Kong Reading for All Day Joint Primary and Secondary School 30-minute Read' will be held at 2:00 p.m. on 23 April 2024, followed immediately by the '30-minute Read'. The event will be held at HKSKH Bishop Hall Secondary School, with a simultaneous live stream available online. The ceremony will include storytelling and sharing of Chinese Classics, resources recommendations from the HKPL, reading aloud the 'Reading Manifesto' and the launching ceremony of '30-minute Read'. In addition to participating in the opening ceremony online, the schools can also send three representatives to attend the ceremony and take part in the reading aloud session of the 'Reading Manifesto' on site. Due to limited seating at the venue, places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. The schools can immediately conduct the '30-minute Read' offline after the launching ceremony, or self-arrange a time to read together with their teachers and students for half an hour on the same day.

4. Schools interested in participating in the captioned activity shall complete the reply slip (Appendix) and return it to the Curriculum Resources Section, Curriculum Development Institute of the EDB by fax at 2304 5258 on or before 12 April 2024 (Friday). All students who attend the opening ceremony of the 'Hong Kong Reading for All Day - Joint Primary and Secondary School 30-minute Read' either online or on site and participate in the '30-minute Read' can apply for an electronic certificate of attendance through their schools after the captioned activity as encouragement.
