National Security Education Day 2024

Summary

This circular memorandum aims to inform heads of primary and secondary schools about the learning and teaching resources and suggested activities consolidated for the National Security Education Day this year.

Background

2. The 15th April was designated as the National Security Education Day. The principle of "one country, two systems" embodies a complete system. Its top priority is to safeguard sovereignty, security and development interests of our country. National security also concerns the core interests of our country and long-term stability of Hong Kong. To nurture teachers' and students' awareness of safeguarding national security, the EDB has consolidated learning and teaching resources and suggested activities related to national security education for schools' use and reference. Schools should also make reference to the **"National Education - Event Planning Calendar"** to organise appropriate school-based activities for teachers and students around the important occasion of the National Security Education Day to encourage their participation, thereby creating a positive atmosphere of safeguarding national security. This year marks the 75th anniversary of the founding of our country. Schools can also connect different national education-related activities to celebrate the National Day.

Details

3. The "Key Speaking Points for National Security Education Day: An Example" (Chinese version only) (Annex 1) and the "Suggested Programmes for the Morning Assembly on the National Security Education Day: An Example" (Annex 2) compiled by the EDB aim to provide recommendations for schools to explain to students the significance of the National Security Education Day and the recent development of national security through morning assemblies, class teacher periods, talks in school halls, etc. In addition, the EDB has also consolidated the suggested learning and teaching activities related to national security education (Annex 3) together with reference materials and websites (Annex 4) for schools' reference.

4. The EDB will continue to disseminate diversified resources related to Constitution, Basic Law and national security education through the webbased resource platform "National Education One-stop Portal" (www.edb.gov.hk/en/neosp) and "National Security Education Resource Webpage" (www.edb.gov.hk/en/nser) to help schools promote national education and national security education, and cultivate in students a sense of national identity and an awareness of safeguarding national security.





5. The Government will organise various kinds of activities around the National Security Education Day for this important occasion. Schools should pay attention to the respective announcements by the Government and encourage the participation of teachers and students.

Key Speaking Points for National Security Education Day: An Example (Chinese Version)

(Suitable for morning assemblies / class teacher periods, etc.)

- 每年4月15日是一年一度的「全民國家安全教育日」。大家知道「全民國家安 全教育日」的源起嗎?於2015年7月1日,全國人民代表大會常委會通過了 《中華人民共和國國家安全法》。自從2016年4月15日,國家開展首個「全 民國家安全教育日」的活動,今年已是第九屆了。政府與社會上不同團體都 會在這個日子舉辦形形色色的活動,目的就是要提升社會大眾對國家安全的 意識,營造維護國家安全的濃厚氛圍。今天我想藉此機會跟大家分享國家安 全的最新發展。
- 國家主席習近平強調國家安全是民族復興的根基,社會穩定是國家強盛的前提。所以,國家必須堅定不移貫徹總體國家安全觀,把維護國家安全貫穿各個方面,以確保我們生活安穩得到保障,免受威嚇。
- 2024年為中華人民共和國成立75周年。國家安全的概念亦隨著國家及國際社 會形勢不斷拓展,以緊貼時代發展與變遷。例如,國家安全重點領域已拓展 至20個,新增的領域包括糧食安全、金融安全、數據安全及人工智能安全都 與我們的生活息息相關,亦是現今世界共同關注的話題。
- 以糧食安全為例子。確保糧食是世界各地關注的大事。中國是擁有14億人口的國家,讓人民溫飽一直是國家關注的頭等大事。因此,國家重視糧食安全,強調提高糧食生產,目標是做到糧食基本自給,不依靠進口,不受外國出口控制。香港與內地唇亡齒寒,我們的整體食物供應主要靠進口食品,當中內地是我們最重要的食物供應來源。我們常說要珍惜世界資源、減少浪費食物, 背後意義非常深遠。
- 我們再談談人工智能安全。人工智能是未來世界科技革命的推動力,我們的 生活不可能不受這股科技浪潮的影響。人工智能為我們帶來機遇,但它也是 一把「雙刀劍」,其衍生的虛假資訊、網絡攻擊等的安全問題已為世界各國所 擔憂,如何防止濫用和侵犯私隱已迫在眉睫。國家非常重視人工智能安全發 展,從法律與教育層面加強對人工智能發展的管理,要做到既重視發展,又 重視安全。所以,國家安全不止於政治與軍事安全,而與我們生活密不可分, 維護國家安全也是全中國人民的共同義務。

 今年是習近平主席提出總體國家安全觀十周年,香港也於今年三月履行了 《基本法》第二十三條本地立法的憲制責任,並已就《基本法》第二十三條 刊憲公布實施《維護國家安全條例》,進一步健全維護國家安全的法律制度。 《維護國家安全條例》為香港建好了安全「屏障」,鞏固了「由亂到治」的「護 土牆」,帶來社會安全,有了安全,才有穩定;有了穩定,才有繁榮。我希望在 今天這個重要日子,讓同學身體力行維護國家安全,成為有承擔、有視野、 愛國愛家的新一代。謝謝。

- To enhance students' understanding of national security, schools can upload the Resources as self-learning materials to the school-based learning platform for students to read the articles and answer questions before and / or after class;
- Teachers can arrange extended learning activities related to national security for students with the appended extended learning materials;
- The Resources can be adopted in life-wide learning activities, such as in setting the themes of inter-class / inter-form competitions (e.g. national security quiz competition);
- Teachers can enrich the school-based teaching materials of various key learning areas / subjects and moral, civic and national education. For example, to strengthen students' understanding of national security, the short articles can be integrated organically into and connected naturally with the teaching of various key learning areas / subjects and moral, civic and national education. Teachers can also make use of the appended multiple-choice questions to consolidate student learning.

• Organise various life-wide learning activities

- Briefly introduce the legislative background, the significance and key concepts of the Hong Kong National Security Law through the school bulletin boards.
- Arrange students to collect information, engage in project learning or share their knowledge on the integral parts of the various major fields of national security, such as cultural security, food security, financial security, data security and artificial intelligence security.
- Organise inter-class / inter-form competitions under the theme of "national security", such as national conditions quiz, bulletin board design, poster design, slogan writing and drama performance.
