This circular memorandum aims to inform primary and secondary schools about the application details of the Diploma Course in Teacher Librarianship (2024-26) and to arrange newly appointed teacher-librarians to attend an Induction Course.

BACKGROUND

2. According to the Codes of Aid for schools, for appointment of teacher-librarian^{1,2}, a teacher should have a minimum of two years' teaching experience. Upon appointment, a teacher-librarian is required, where appropriate, to complete a part-time day-release training course or other professional training course organised by the Education Bureau.

Details will be provided later in the letters to respective schools.
