Digital Education Centre of Excellence

Summary

This circular aims to inform schools that the “IT in Education Centre of Excellence” under the Education Bureau (“EDB”) has been renamed the “Digital Education Centre of Excellence” and outline its services.

Background

2. To align with the national strategy for the digitalisation of education and nurture talents in innovation and technology, the EDB will continue to promote digital education in primary and secondary schools. The focus of digital education is to enhance students’ digital literacy and skills and to nurture them to become responsible citizens and lifelong learners. The EDB has been supporting schools through diverse strategies, including providing teacher training and professional support, to help schools formulate school-based plans for the digitalisation of learning according to their specific circumstances and development needs. This enables schools to make good use of information and innovative technology to enhance learning and teaching effectiveness.

Details

3. In line with the above strategy to promote digital education, the “IT in Education Centre of Excellence” has been officially renamed the “Digital Education Centre of Excellence” (“CoE”). The CoE comprises serving teachers seconded to the EDB who have successful experience in implementing digital education. The EDB annually invites government and aided primary and secondary schools, special schools and Direct Subsidy Scheme schools to join the CoE Scheme through the Circular Memorandum on the Annual Teacher Secondment Exercise. In this school year (2024/25), a total of 13 primary, secondary, and special schools have been selected as CoE schools.



4. The EDB, in collaboration with the CoE schools and relevant organisations, continues to strengthen on-site support services and teacher professional training (especially in artificial intelligence in education) to facilitate other schools in developing digital education. The details are as follows:

On-site Support Services

5. The CoE aims to support schools in implementing digital education and e-learning. Schools are encouraged to apply for the on-site support services provided by the CoE. These services are open for school applications throughout the year, divided into six major series: Artificial Intelligence, Pedagogy, e-Leadership, Technical Support, Subject-related and Information Literacy. Purpose of Collection

1. The personal data provided by you in this form will be used by the EDB for one or more of the following purposes:

- (a) Activities relating to the processing, authentication and counter-checking of the form for application for support services;
- (b) Activities relating to matching of the personal data with the database of other relevant Government bureaux / departments in connection with the processing, authentication and counter-checking of the application mentioned in (a) above;
- (c) Activities relating to matching of the personal data within the database of EDB for purposes of verifying / updating records of the EDB;
- (d) Activities relating to training and development including invitation of participation in programmes/activities, applications for reimbursement of course fees, assessment of nominations, awards and scholarship, and monitoring of attainment progress;
- (e) Activities relating to the processing and vetting of applications for, and disbursement of, funding / grants / subsidies, and conducting of audits;
- (f) Activities relating to compilation of statistics, research and Government publications; and
- (g) Activities relating to the administration and enforcement of rules and regulations including the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279), its subsidiary legislation (such as the Education Regulations and the Grant/Subsidized Schools Provident Fund Rules) and the Codes of Aid.

2. The provision of personal data required by this form and during the processing of this form is obligatory. In the event that you do not provide those personal data, we may not be able to handle or further process the application.

Classes of Transferees

3. The personal data you provide will be made available to persons working in EDB. Apart from this, they may be transferred or disclosed to the parties or in the circumstances listed below:-

- (a) other Government bureau and departments, including Education Bureau, for the purposes mentioned in paragraph 1 above;
- (b) the school in which the form relates for the purposes mentioned in paragraph 1 above;
- (c) where you have given your prescribed consent to such disclosure; and
- (d) where such disclosure is authorised or required under the law or court order applicable to Hong Kong.
