Summary

This circular memorandum invites applications from heads of all secondary, primary schools and kindergartens of the 28th Moral and Civic Education Award Scheme (the Award Scheme) organised by Yan Chai Hospital and co-organised by the Education Bureau.

Details

2. The Award Scheme, subsidised by the Moral and Civic Education Fund set up by Yan Chai Hospital, aims to support schools in promoting moral and civic education and reinforcing character building of students and training in civic responsibility. It also seeks to develop students' moral sense and civic awareness at various levels, ranging from family (care and responsibility), society (civic awareness and obligation), country (sense of belonging and national identity) to universal values (sustainable development), so as to nurture a new generation with an affection for our country, the city and the family.

Organisers	: Organised by Yan Chai Hospital and co-organised by the Education Bureau
Aims	: To facilitate the promotion of moral education and civic education in all secondary and primary schools and kindergartens so as to enhance character building of students and their sense of civic responsibility, and to better cultivate their moral sense and civic awareness.
Themes	: Schools to work out projects with reference to the twelve priority values and attitudes promoted by the Education Bureau: “Perseverance”, “Respect for Others”, “Responsibility”, “National Identity”, “Commitment”, “Integrity”, “Benevolence”, “Law-abidingness”, “Empathy”, “Diligence”, “Unity” and “Filial Piety”. The projects should achieve at least one of the following objectives: 1. To nurture students’ benevolence and responsibility towards their family; 2. To raise civic awareness and a sense of obligation towards society in students; 3. To develop students’ sense of belonging towards our country, and national identity and enhance their understanding of motherland; 4. To promote patriotic education by enhancing students’ knowledge on the history and development of our country, consolidate their national pride, cultivate their sense of responsibility and ownership, and better integrate them into the overall development of our country; 5. To promote education for sustainable development and raise students’ care for sustainable development around the globe and the common good for human beings; 6. To develop a curriculum, activities, projects, research studies, surveys and innovative initiatives related to moral and civic education, including advocacy of traditional Chinese virtues such as filial piety, politeness, offering seats to the needy and showing respect for the aged; sex education and education for media and information literacy; and 7. To promote a healthy campus, strengthen anti-drug awareness and promote anti-drug education.
Target participants	: All secondary and primary schools and kindergartens (including Government, Aided, Direct Subsidy Scheme, Caput and Private Schools)
Awards	: A total of 60 awards will be presented to secondary and primary schools and kindergartens in the 2025/2026 school year. Each school may submit

more than one application. Each successful proposal will be awarded an activity grant of \$5,000 (to be disbursed in two instalments of \$2,500 each).

Adjudication : Proposals will be assessed by the adjudicating panel on the basis of their innovativeness (30%), scale (20%), effectiveness (20%), practicability (15%) and promotability (15%). The decisions of the adjudicating panel shall be final.
