Territory-wide Inter-school National Security Knowledge Challenge (2025/26)

Summary

This circular memorandum aims to invite schools to take part in the “Territory-wide Inter-school National Security Knowledge Challenge (2025/26)” jointly organised by the Department of Justice (DoJ), the Security Bureau (SB), the Education Bureau (EDB) and Shine Tak Foundation.

Background

2. To continue embedding national security education in schools and strengthen students’ understanding of different areas and laws related to national security, including the Constitution, the Basic Law, the Hong Kong National Security Law and the Safeguarding National Security Ordinance, to raise their awareness of safeguarding national security, the DoJ, the SB, the EDB and Shine Tak Foundation will continue to jointly organise the “Territory-wide Inter-school National Security Knowledge Challenge (2025/26)” this school year to encourage the participation of students across the territory, create a good atmosphere for safeguarding national security, and synergise efforts towards safeguarding national security. The activity ties in with the National Day on 1 October and the National Security Education Day on 15 April annually. As this year marks the 80th anniversary of the victory in the War of Resistance, related questions will also be included in the Competition.

Details

3. The “Territory-wide Inter-school National Security Knowledge Challenge (2025/26)” is divided into the primary section, secondary section and the English Category for non-Chinese speaking (NCS) secondary students. Participating students of the primary and secondary sections have to complete the Online Heat Round. Schools that obtain the highest score from the Online Heat Round will be invited to participate in the Onsite Team Competition to be held in November 2025 and 15 April 2026. At the same time, the primary and secondary schools with the highest participation rate in the Online Heat Round will receive the “Active Participating School Award”. For the competition details, enrolment methods and awards, please refer to **Annex 1** (Online

Heat Round) and **Annex 2** (Onsite Team Competition).

4. As to the competition details, enrolment method and awards of the English Category for non-Chinese speaking (NCS) secondary students, please refer to **Annex 3** (English Category for NCS secondary students).

5. Schools with outstanding performance will have the opportunity to be invited to join the “National Security Education Study Tour” for exchange and visits on the Mainland.

Number of Participants




- There is no limit on the number of student participants from each school. All students are encouraged to participate. Each student can only attempt the online quiz competition once. Students found to have attempted more than once will be disqualified. There is no appeal mechanism in the competition.

Competition Format

- In the Online Heat Round, students have to answer 20 multiple-choice questions with a time limit of 5 minutes in total. Some of the questions are based on the content of the following websites, videos and learning resources. Schools are recommended to encourage students to read the relevant content before the competition:

Awards

- An electronic certificate will be awarded to each participating student.
- The top three students with the highest scores in the Online Heat Round will win the individual championship, first runner-up, and second runner-up in their respective sections and will be awarded with prizes and trophies etc. as encouragement. In case of a tie, the student having answered the questions within a shorter time will win.
- The 30 primary schools and 30 secondary schools with the highest participation rate (calculated based on the total number of participating students) in the Online Heat Round will receive the “Active Participating School Award”.

Points to Note

1. Schools should update their students’ accounts with the Hong Kong Education City for the current school year prior to the submission of an entry form, and inform their students of the account information accordingly before the competition. For details, please contact the teacher in charge or the Information Technology Co-ordinator of the school. For further assistance, please contact the Hong Kong Education City.
2. The information submitted by schools in the “Entry Form” will be used for the “Territory-wide Inter-school National Security Knowledge Challenge (2025/26)”. Participating schools should ensure that all information provided is correct before submitting the “Entry Form”. Provision of incorrect information may affect their eligibility for entering the competition and results.

Annex 2

Territory-wide Inter-school National Security Knowledge Challenge (2025/26) Onsite Team Competition Competition Details

Sections

- Primary Section: Students from Primary 1 to 6
- Secondary Section: Students from Secondary 1 to 6

Eligibility

- During the Online Heat Round, the score of each school is the average number of questions scored by the five students of that school having correctly answered most questions.
- In case of a tie, the total time used in answering the questions by the abovementioned five students will be compared in deciding the ranking. Schools with a shorter average time used in answering the questions will be ranked higher.
- The 27 primary schools and 27 secondary schools with the highest scores will be invited to form teams to participate in the Onsite Team Competition of the primary and secondary sections respectively.
- Each school must send a team of five students to participate in the Onsite Team Competition.

Competition Format and Awards

- All school representatives invited to participate in the Onsite Team Competition will receive certificates and souvenirs.
- Schools participating in the Onsite Team Competition will compete in knockout rounds (including the quarter-final, the semi-final, and the final). The ranking will be determined through the onsite question and answer session.
- The champion, first runner-up and second runner-up in the Onsite Team Competition will receive prizes, trophies and so on as encouragement.

Points to Note

- Schools that have won the Online Heat Round and entered into the Onsite Team Competition will be notified of the details on the arrangements (including the competition time, venue and rules) and contact methods.
- If a school is unable to send student representatives to attend the Onsite Team Competition, it will be replaced by another school according to the ranking in the Online Heat Round.
- The Organising Committee has the final decision on the eligibility for the Onsite Team Competitions.
- The Organising Committee will arrange a TV station to film the process of the Onsite Team Competition and award ceremony, and arrangements will be made for the highlights of the competition to be broadcast on TV and government websites. Photos and videos related to the competition may also be published on the Government's social media platforms, in newspapers or on promotional materials. The participation of schools and students in the Onsite Team Competition would be taken as consents from the schools, students and their parents to the above arrangements.

- Interested schools should submit completed application form in **Annex 3A** by email (mcne3@edb.gov.hk) to the Moral, Civic and National Education Section 3 of the Curriculum Development Institute, Education Bureau **on or before 30 September 2025 (Tuesday)**. Applications will be processed on a **first-come-first-serve basis**.
- 12 schools successfully enrolled in the English Category for NCS secondary students will be invited to participate in the Team Competition. There will not be any Online Heat Round for the English Category.
- Each school must send a team of five NCS students to participate in the Team Competition.
- Schools successfully enrolled for the English Category will be notified of the details (including the competition time, venue, rules and contact methods) of the Team Competition.

Points to Note

- The Organising Committee has the final decision on the eligibility for schools to participate in the Team Competitions.
- The Organising Committee will arrange filming of the process of the Team Competition and award ceremony, and arrangements will be made for the highlights of the competition to be broadcast on TV and government websites. Photos and

videos related to the competition may also be published on the Government's social media platforms, in newspapers or on promotional materials. The participation of schools and students in the Team Competition would be taken as consents from the schools, students and their parents to the above arrangements.

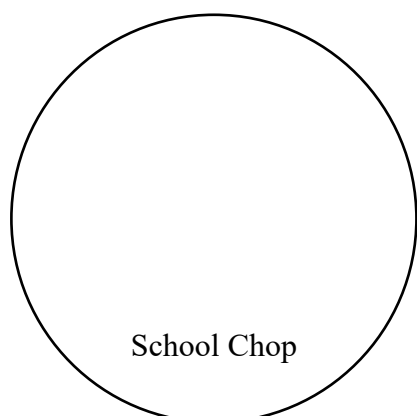
